Kellogg Salada Canada, Inc. began a "mail-in" offer for six miniature houses from the Whimsey-on-Why series from September to December 1984.

All twenty figurines were made available in 1992 as a "mail-in" offer with Red Rose Decaffeinated Tea. It has been reported that a few of the figurines were in slightly different glazes but in general they were identical to the original twenty. A mold variation of the Langur was issued with a gap between the stump and head.

The Polar Bear was first issued in the Tom Smith "Survival" set, the Spotted Owl was first issued as the Barn Owl in the UK 2 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ Whimsies, and the Bald Eagle was first issued in the Whimsie-Land "British Wildlife" set - all used again here with different glazes. Seven of the figurines were new molds used for the first time in this US series.
